Church Creek	Shares an entrance with Crab Creek One of the most beautiful anchorages on the bay. Try the cove just inside the entrance or the cove just beyond the sharp point to starboard.	9.5
Annapolis Harbour	Annapolis town centre	12.5
Mill Creek on Whitehall Bay	Cantler's Riverside Inn-crabs Good Summer anchorage behind North Shoal south of Hacker Pt	13.5
Weems Creek	The first creek above the bridges. Anchor just inside the entrance. There is a dingy dock a short walk from the shopping district of West Annapolis. Good place for a land and sea raft.	14
Salt Water Creek	A quiet spot on off the Severn. There are Navy moorings at the entrance that can be used or anchor near its head waters.	15
Tilghman Creek on Miles	Explore by dinghy. Hard to spot and tricky entrance Narrow entrance opens into a beautiful spot.	19
Crab Alley Creek Eastern Bay	Explore by dinghy. Still a fair number of work boats here.	20
Dobbins Island on Magothy	Large sandy beach. Can get crowded.	20
Forked Creek on Magothy	South shore Lovely spot next to the Lynch Estate	
Dividing Creek on Magothy	High banks make this a good anchorage early and late in the season or when you expect a good blow	22
St. Michael's	St. Michael's town centre	22
Drum Point on Wye	Sandy beach, woodland walks	22.5
Dividing & Granary Creeks on Wye	Explore by Dinghy Beautiful setting, lots of wild life. Lots of geese in late October.	23.5

Swan Creek	Rockhall town centre	25
Queenstown Creek on Chester	Small town centre Small anchorage, easy walk to town ctr. Can tie up for short periods at town dock	28.5
Island Creek on Choptank	Shoal entrance, 6ft max	30
Baby Owl cove on Choptank	Woodland walks	30
Plain Dealing Creek on Tred Avon	Oxford town centre	30.5
Hudson Creek on Little Choptank	Large sandy beach	31
San Domingo Creek on Choptank	Backdoor to St. Michael's town centre Three feet or less at the town dock.	31.5
La Trappe Creek on Choptank	Explore by Dinghy One of the best on the Bay. Can be crowded Large sandy spit to port on entering	31.5
Fairlee Creek	Great Oak Landing Pool and Restaurant	32
Langford Creek on Chester	Cacaway Island beaches Beautiful spot.	33
Corsica River	Former estate of John Raskob is now a Russian Retreat. Good anchorage at mouth of Emory Creek County wharf at Centerville Landing for those coming by car	33
Reed and Grove Creeks on Chester	Explore by Dinghy Note well known, worth exploring	33.5
Grays Inn Creek on Chester	Tough entrance, but worth the effort	32
Baltimore Inner Harbour	City Centre	34
Cambridge Yacht Basin	Cambridge town centre Limited tie up area, shallow Rt 50 bridge at 50 ft.	35
Worton Creek	Explore by Dinghy	35.5
Still Pond	Unique chute ride on falling tide. Enter Still Pond Creek at slack water as there quite a tidal current.	40
